ABOUT THE PROJECT

The project is part of a larger initiative by the National Commission for Women to conduct Women's safety audit in 12 (Twelve) tier II cities in India. NLUO has been granted the project to undertake the survey for the city of Asansol (West Bengal).

The project will assess the level of safety experienced by women in public spaces and workspaces in the city on the basis of a sample survey of approximately 4000 respondents, focus group discussions (FGDs) & stakeholder's meetings. On the basis of information gathered from these, NLUO will prepare a Report and a Women's Security Score Card for the city of Asansol.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The engagement of the Project Manager and Project Associate is not against any regular post and is limited to the duration of the project. The engagement shall not confer any right for permanent/regular job or absorption at NLUO.
- In case of unsatisfactory performance, NLUO reserves the right to terminate the contract before the expiry of one year.
- During the duration of the project, the Project Manager and Project Associate are required to stay in Asansol, West Bengal and make their own arrangements for stay and food.

More specifically, the roles and responsibilities are: Identification, recruitment and training of enumerators for field survey; Liaison with the relevant institutions such as municipalities, police, judiciary, local administration, panchayat raj, educational institutions, hospitals, training institutes, local enterprises, etc., to conduct the women safety audits; Devise effective methodology to undertake field survey and focus group discussions in consultation with the Core Team; Organise stakeholder consultation meetings; Travel within the project area in Asansol to monitor field survey by enumerators (field investigators); and Preparation of report.

Project Associate: To assist the project manager in the effective and timely completion of the project.
