Terms and Condition of Service for the post of Nurse

- 1. The Nurse will assist the in House Doctor in providing health services to University students, employees and their family members.
- 2. The Nurse needs to be present in the University Dispensary during the visit of the University Doctor as per the following schedule and on Call in case of emergency.

Monday – Friday	Morning: 10.00 A.M. – 1.00 P.M.	6 Hours
	Evening: 5.00 P.M. – 8.00 P.M.	
Sunday	10.00 A.M. – 12.00 Noon	2 Hours

In addition to the above the Nurse has to be present in the campus from 3.00 - 5.00 P.M. working days. The total duty hour of Nurse on any working day will be 8 hours.

- 3. University has a wellness center as designated seating place for the Doctor and Nurse.
- 4. The Nurse will be available in University campus during the doctor's visit to the University to assist him/her as per the above schedule.
- 5. Some basic medicines will be provided in the wellness centre.
- 6. The Nurse may avail leave at par with other contractual employees of the University.
- 7. The Nurse needs to be available on call in case of emergency.
- 8. The University will maintain a register for the record purpose of the patients (students/employees/employees' family) visiting the dispensary for check up along with the medicines prescribed.
- 9. The Nurse will be provided a consolidated remuneration Rs.25, 000/- per month.
- 10. The Nurse will oversee the maintenance of the wellness Center as advised by the Doctor.
- 11. The Nurse will maintain good and cordial relationship with the students and employees of the University.
- 12. The Initial appointment will be purely contractual. However, based on satisfactory Performance, University may regularize the service as per the NLUO Recruitments and Promotions Rules.
