The Vice-Chancellor appraised the members about the recent NIRF ranking 2020, wherein NLU Odisha has been ranked 9th among other National Law Universities and 14th among all Law Schools/Universities in India. Further the University was ranked Fifth in the "Perception" parameter. This is the first time, NLUO entered in to the NIRF framework. The Vice-Chancellor placed on record the continuous support and guidance of the Hon'ble Visitor, Hon'ble Chancellor and all University Bodies. This is the collective effort of all teachers, staff and Students

4	Constitution of the Search Committee	<p>The Council was appraised that Government of Odisha by letter dated 25 June 2020 has communicated that State Government has already approved the amendment in the Clause (5) of the Statute 18 of the Statutes of the NLUO as: "The term of the Vice-Chancellor shall be for five years from the date on which he enters upon his office or until he attains the age of Seventy years whichever is earlier. The incumbent Vice-Chancellor shall be eligible for re-appointment for second term of five years or until he attains the age of Seventy years, whichever is earlier."</p> <p>The Council resolved that matter now may be placed before the General Council for necessary action.</p>
5	Any other Item with the permission of the Chair	<p>The Vice-Chancellor informed the council that NLU Odisha is ranked 9th among NLUs and 14th Place in Law Schools of India ranking in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), MHRD, Government of India.</p> <p>The Council appreciated the collective efforts of the VC, Faculty, Students and</p>

The Advocate General raised the issue of appointment of a Regular Registrar and Finance Officer of the University as no one found suitable in the last selection process.</p> <p>The Council resolved that as far as office of the Registrar is concerned, a person from academic will be more suited. Therefore, a faculty member from the University may discharge the function of the Registrar.</p> <p>Regarding Finance Officer, the Council resolved that University will write letter to Government so that a Finance Officer from a Central/State University or State Government may be appointed on deputation basis.</p>
